ORDINANCE NO. 1568

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 5 ENTITLED "AMUSEMENTS", OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TEANECK, NEW JERSEY, 1964, AS AMENDED, BY DELETING THEREFROM SEC. 5-1, SEC. 5-8(b) AND SEC. 5-8(e) AND SUBSTITUTING THEREFOR A NEW SEC. 5-1, SEC. 5-8(b) AND SEC. 5-8(e), AND BY DELETING THEREFROM IN THEIR ENTIRETY SEC. 5-14 AND SEC. 5-15.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Teaneck, as follows:

SECTION 1. That Sec. 5-1 entitled "Licenses - Required" of said Chapter 5 entitled "Amusements", be deleted in its entirety, and the following substituted therefor:

"Sec. 5-1. Licenses - Required.

No person, whether owner or sponsor, unless duly licensed in accordance with the provisions of this Article, shall have, keep, own or maintain within the Township any billiardrooms or poolrooms, dance halls, skating rinks, roller derby, bowling alleys, tennis courts, squash courts, swimming pools, golf courses or other places where amusement or recreation of the public is carried on as a business. "

SECTION 2. That Sec. 5-8 entitled "Same - fees" of said Chapter 5 entitled "Amusements", be amended by deleting therefrom the subparagraphs marked "(b)" and "(e)", and substituting the following therefor:

"Sec. 5-8. Same - fees.

(b) Dance halls, skating rinks, golf courses, \$500.00 per year.

(e) Tennis courts, squash courts, \$10.00 per year per court. "

SECTION 3. That Sec. 5-14 entitled "Buildings to be open to public view" and Sec. 5-15 entitled "Businesses to be conducted at street level; exception as to bowling alleys" of said Chapter 5 entitled "Amusements" be deleted in their entirety.

SECTION 4. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances contrary to or inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect after publication thereof after final passage, as provided by law.
