Your April 16, 2024 Open Public Records Act request seeks:

1. the resolution or document memorializing this decision of the Board, and
2. I am also requesting pursuant to OPRA the Minutes of any public or closed/executive session discussion regarding aid-in-lieu payments for nonpublic schools for the 2024-25 school year between 1/1/23 and present.

There are no responsive records to your first request. N.J.S.A. 18A:39-1a states boards of education shall not expend more than the maximum per student expenditure for nonpublic school transportation. Compliance with NJSA 18A:39-1a, and all laws of the State, is obligatory.
